PNB KNOWLEDGE FORUM 2025 CHAMPIONS TRANSFORMATION AS A NATIONAL IMPERATIVE

Themed "Transformation" the forum explores how Malaysia can redefine wealth creation, strengthen institutions, and empower individuals to thrive in a rapidly evolving global economy

KUALA LUMPUR, 21 October 2025: Permodalan Nasional Berhad (PNB) today hosted the PNB Knowledge Forum 2025 (PKF 2025), highlighting the In-Conversation session with YAB Prime Minister, Dato' Seri Anwar bin Ibrahim. Organised by PNB Research Institute (PNBRI), PKF 2025 brought together global thinkers, national leaders, corporate architects, and personal voices to chart how transformation shapes economies, organisations, and lives.

Themed "Transformation", the forum explored it as a multidimensional process driven by global geopolitical shifts, evolving norms, and the need for Malaysia to redefine its approach to economic resilience, institutional strength, and sustainable growth.

YM Raja Tan Sri Dato' Seri Arshad Raja Tun Uda, Group Chairman of PNB, emphasised the Prime Minister's holistic transformation vision for Malaysia that goes beyond economic reforms alone, encompassing leadership governance, institutional integrity, societal equity, and cultural heritage. He noted that the MADANI Economic Framework serves as the blueprint to strengthen fiscal responsibility and empower the rakyat while positioning Malaysia competitively on the global stage.

Other speakers included YBhg Dato' Sri Khairussaleh Ramli, President & Group Chief Executive Officer of Maybank; YBhg Dato' Seri Azmir Merican, Group Managing Director & CEO of Sime Darby Property; and inspiring personal stories from entrepreneur Venon Tian of ZUS Coffee, sustainability leader Melati Wijsen of Bye Bye Plastic Bags, and actorcomedian Douglas Lim.
